NOW LET'S GO CATCH SOME SOULS FOR JESUS

WE ARE ALL CALLED TO BE “*FISHERS OF MEN*”

This little message is for all my friends who love fishing — but don't worry — even if you have never caught a fish in your life — the spiritual truths and analogies herein will speak powerfully to your heart and spirit — and make you want to go fishing!

So let's kick this off with a question — **DO YOU HAVE ANY IDEA HOW MUCH GOD MUST LOVE FISHERMEN?**

He truly must — as at least four of the disciples He chose were fishermen by trade — and both scripture and church tradition suggest that as many as seven or more of the original twelve disciples were initially fishermen — John 21:1-3.

But regardless of their former vocations one thing we can be absolutely certain of is that once Jesus called them — all 12 were immediately commissioned to become Fishermen For Souls — and so are you and I.

So here is another question:
— we have all heard these immortal words of Jesus but how many have truly taken them to heart — *“Follow Me and — I WILL MAKE YOU FISHERS OF MEN.”* Matthew 4:19

But why did Jesus choose so many fishermen — I believe there is strong likelihood it was so He could use their ingrained talents — and teach them how to employ the **FISHING SKILLS THEY ALREADY HAD** — as He transitioned them into a new type of fishing.

Because that is what Evangelism is really all about — **FISHING** — with the primary objective to attract the fish — to lure them — bait them — get them to bite — set the hook — and then gently

but firmly land them in the Gospel Boat.

But it should be readily apparent that you cannot simply hand a person a rod, a line and a hook and expect them to catch and land fish — of course anyone can get lucky and catch the odd fish — but there is a finesse to the art of fishing — a learned skill — a multitude of techniques and tactics — and a certain feel coupled with instant reflexes required to truly and consistently land fish — especially the Big Ones!

Which is why I love to get out on the water where I can practice and hone my — **EVANGELISM SKILLS** — especially since there are so many similarities between fishing for fish and fishing for men.

At least that is my excuse and I am sticking with it — because I love fishing — and I love the feel of that sudden hard jerk on the end of the line that keeps on jerking!

And almost everyone knows I am an incurable workaholic — which means

my mind never shuts down — it is filled day and night with preaching, campaigns, travel, writing magazines, writing books and so much more — but when I get out on a lake or out on the salt chuck with a rod in my hand — it's easy to leave the rest of the world and its myriad of pressures behind — and become completely engrossed with the joy of catching the next big one!

And while out fishing with friends on the west coast of BC between Gospel meetings these last few weeks — catching a mess of halibut, ling cod and yellow eyes — plus a myriad of salmon — God began to speak a phrase in my spirit over and over — as I kept hearing these words: **“THE FISHERMAN ANOINTING.”**



For there is not only a special skill which can be learned and developed — but also a special anointing and empowerment of the Holy Spirit to be a true Fisherman for God and for Souls!

My proof text for that point is found in Acts 1:8 — *“But you shall receive **POWER — unction — anointing — empowerment — Holy Ghost infilling — to be My WITNESSES — to be MY FISHERMEN TO CATCH SOULS — to the ends of the earth!**”*

Now before we dive into a number of exhilarating fishing analogies — we should note something very special in the Bible — as this term — **“FISHERS OF MEN”** — is referenced in all four Gospels — three times specifically and one time inferred — so you can well imagine the import of these words of Jesus!

Especially since certain events and details are only mentioned in one of the four Gospels — some in two — and extremely important issues a full three times — but four times indicates this Call to be Fishers of Men must be of paramount importance to God — which means it must be to us as well.

The first reference is in the first of the three synoptic Gospels — as Jesus calls Peter and Andrew with these words in Matthew 4:19 — *“Follow Me and I will make you fishers of men”* — which phrase is repeated verbatim in Mark 1:17 — and the third is in the book of Luke 5 verse 10 where He states — *“From now on you will catch men”* — while the Gospel of John briefly mentions the story and Jesus only says — *“Follow Me”* — *John 1:43* — but the overarching commission remains the same.

But the narrative with the most detail is found in the Gospel of Luke 5:1-11 — where Jesus preaches from Peter's boat, commands a miraculous catch of fish, and then tells Peter that from that day forward he will be catching people.

A great multitude was pressing about Jesus to hear the Word of God — and Jesus borrows

Peter's boat — pushes out from shore a little and teaches the hungry masses and when He was finished He instructs Simon Peter to — *“Launch out into the deep and let down your net for a catch.”* *Luke 5:9*

Note that term — **LAUNCH OUT INTO THE DEEP** — which immediately reveals the reason why most people and most churches are not catching many if any fish — or more accurately souls — because they are — **FISHING IN THE BATHTUB!**

Fishing in the Church — within the four walls of the religious sanctuary — where the Sunday-go-to-meeting crowd has heard the message a thousand times — and are supposed to already be saved — that is not where the lost and needy are — the fish that still need to be caught are on the outside — and most of them are so turned off with religion they have no desire to ever enter a church!

Which is why Jesus said — *“Go out into the **HIGHWAYS AND THE BIWAYS** and compel them to come in, that my house may be filled.”* *Luke 14:23*

But Simon answered and said to Him — *“Master, we have toiled all night and caught nothing”* — have you ever had that experience — fished all day and not a single bite — going home skunked — but we will never be skunked if we believe God's Word — and declare as Peter did:

“NEVERTHELESS — AT THY WORD — I will let the net down!” *Luke 5:5*

That is the key to a miracle — no matter what your need or what the condition — skunked — failed — ready to give up — almost ready to chuck your rod in the lake out of fruitless frustration — nevertheless — at the **IMMUTABLE UNFAILING MIRACLE PRODUCING WORD OF GOD** — *“I will believe and I will let down the net.”* *Luke 5:6*

*“And when they had done this, they caught a great number of fish, and — **THEIR NET WAS BREAKING**”* — note that statement — the Pre-



Cross net could not hold the mass of fish which were caught!!

*"So they signalled to their **PARTNERS** in the other boat to come and help them. And they came and **FILLED BOTH THE BOATS**, so that they began to sink." Luke 5:7*

That is the power of — **PARTNERSHIP IN FISHING** — just as surely as it is with — **PARTNERSHIP IN MISSIONS** — fill both the boats — fill your own boat and fill all your partner's boats to overflowing!!!

Now take special note of this marvellous truth which the Lord quickened to my spirit as I meditated on this scripture.

Peter lent his boat to Jesus — and received a haul of fish so great it not only filled his boat but also his partner's boat to the point they were so overloaded that both boats were almost sinking — and then tie that verse to this promise of God.

*"He who has pity on the poor **LEND**S TO THE LORD, And He will **PAY BACK** what he has given." Proverbs 19:17*

And who is so poor as those who have never heard about Jesus — those who are still lost in their sins — which is why we all need to get involved in fishing!!!

So often we think of giving to Jesus and to Missions as something we release and no longer have — but here God calls it lending to the Lord — with a firm guarantee that it will be given back — many-fold and in many ways — and especially and most importantly by eternal riches in Christ.

And when Peter saw the great haul of fish — *"he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying — 'Depart from me, for I **AM A SINFUL MAN**, O Lord'"* — which clearly reveals how the manifest miracle power of Christ convinces and convicts the human heart — for they were all astonished at the great catch of fish — including James and John — who were **PARTNERS** with Peter and Andrew!

It is at this point in the story that Jesus says to Simon Peter — *"Do not be afraid. From now on — **YOU WILL CATCH MEN** — and they forsook all and followed Him."* Luke 5: 11

The next great parable on fishing that Jesus expounded upon is found in Matthew 13:47-48 where in the midst of a lengthy series of analogies about the Kingdom of God He stated:

*"Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a — **DRAGNET** — that was cast into the sea and gathered some of every kind, which, when it was full, they drew to shore; and they sat down and gathered the good into vessels, but threw the bad away."*

Note those words — **SOME OF EVERY KIND** — some good — some bad — some beautiful looking — some ugly as sin — but the dragnet gathered them all.

Which is somewhat indicative of the thrill of fishing in the ocean — especially when you are bottom fishing — as you never know what is going to come up from the ocean floor that is 280 to 300 feet below — or what is jerking on the end of your line — as some of those bottom

creatures look like prehistoric monsters — some such as ling cod that are almost all head, teeth and sharp spiked fins — and some that simply make you wonder what in the world it is.

Much like my shock and amazement the first time I caught a halibut many years ago — with its big flat white flat belly that slides or hides along the bottom waiting to lunge out at its prey — with a totally contrasting dark brownish top — its head and mouth turned a full 90 degrees sideways like it has been weirdly twisted in a completely different direction — and two buggy eyes sticking out the top half of its warped head.

Which made me wonder — Lord, what were You thinking when you created such a bizarre looking fish — and yet made it so mighty fine to eat!



But the key point is — THEY ALL BITE AND THEY ALL COME UP — and in the Bible analogy the good were kept and the bad thrown away — but it is not so when it comes to how we fish for souls — which leads us to one of the most important principles of fishing for men!

For when I fish for souls nothing is thrown back — all are welcome — all are precious — all are worth more than the whole world.

As Jesus said — *“For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?”* Mark 8:36-37

Thus in the economy of God — there is no respect of persons — and no class distinctions — all are precious — and every soul is worth more than all the world — and if you want to be a true fisherman for God you must understand the intrinsic value God has placed on each and every soul — regardless of status, position, colour, creed, country or religious or political persuasion.

To illustrate this point — over my almost 50 full years of ministry — I have had the privilege to pray with virtually every strata of society — as I have prayed with kings of nations — prime ministers — presidents — heads of state — army generals — billionaires — millionaires — Wall Street executives — businessmen — doctors — psychiatrists — bankers and lawyers — and I have also prayed with pimps and pushers and prostitutes — hardcore bikers and strikers — street people — the homeless — alcoholics — and drug addicts!

With those who live in mansions and those who sleep in cardboard boxes — with the up-and-outers and the down-and-outers — with the uttermost and the guttermost — and I treat them all the same — for God loves them all the same!

And I fish for all of them — not a single one is discarded or thrown back — and if I catch them I

trust God to keep them — for it was none other than Jesus Himself who declared — *“Whosoever comes to Me I will in no wise cast out!”* John 6:37

Now let's move on to some key analogies about fishing — remembering that the majority of Jesus's teaching was done through parables — simple real life issues which He used to illustrate spiritual truths — common elements of daily life that the people could easily understand — such as salt — light — seeds — crops, etc — and let's not forget one of His favoured topics — fishing!

So much comes into the art of fishing — as every species and every environment demands a special approach — such as time of year — are the fish running or have they migrated elsewhere — the depth the fish are swimming at — sunny or cloudy day — temperature of water — what they are feeding on — having the right gear — and much much more.



And when they do bite — to know how to set the drag on your reel properly for the variable strength and pull of the size of fish — a critical key to playing your fish.

For if your drag is set too tight the fish — especially if it is a big one — will use its immense strength to run hard and snap your line clean off — and if the drag is set too loose it will use that split second of slack line to spit the hook and be gone bye-bye.

So the key is to keep constant pressure on the fish — but not too hard — just enough to hold it firm and still let it run — rod up

high — no slack — pressure constantly on — let him run and the moment he stops reel like crazy until he decides to run again.

And if you play the fish right — he will eventually tire out — just like that resistant soul you are trying to reach — to the point you get him to the side of the boat and it will literally roll onto its side — totally exhausted — no fight left — and ready to say — I give up — I'm ready to accept Jesus!!!

I know — I've caught some very huge salmon out

on the ocean that way — plus a lot of big fish in our meetings — but you cannot simply hook them and then try to reef them in like they are tied to a big winch.

You need to play them — let the reel scream as they make a 50 or 100 yard dash run — and guard your knuckles so they don't get beat off by the fiercely spinning nobs on your reel — then play them back and forth to the boat — which challenging fight is what puts an extra exciting thrill into the art and sportsmanship of fishing!

But there is still one more extremely crucial analogical point to make on catching fish and that is — **THE BAIT** — because if you don't use the right bait you will spend the entire day simply — **WASHING LURES!**

There are thousands of different types of gear to use — hoochies — spoons — spinners — plugs — flies — flashers — jigs — buzz bombs — fresh bait — cut bait — live bait.

And they come in every colour and assortment you can imagine — and they all have their place — but the key is to know what the specific species of fish in that area are feeding on.

Which is why sometimes on a slow day fishing I keep changing tackle over and over — and when someone finally catches a fish I like to look down its throat to see what they are eating — or if need be — slit its belly open to see what's inside — minnows — squid — herring — needle fish or whatever — and then I open my tackle box to find something that looks the same and suddenly — **THE BITE IS ON!**

And the bait changes with every species and every environment — including the time of day and the shades of water — and it is exactly the same when fishing for souls — as there are a myriad of different needs in this world — and not all experience the same need at the same time — so when preaching or sharing Jesus — you need to find out the specific need is — and then use the appropriate bait!

And one of the greatest hindrances to fishing for men and catching souls is to bait your hook with — **THE LAW** — brow-beating people with a long list of — Thou Shall Not Do This — and Thou Shall Not Do That — which amounts to nothing more than a bunch of religious laws and rules and regulations which they themselves have not had the power to keep — and which drives the ones you hope to reach even further into condemnation and a sense of unworthiness — reinforcing the false religious presumption that God is mad at them and they could never be accepted by God!

Imagine the dilemma — do we have any idea how many people stay away from church and religious people simply because they have been beat around the ears with a 10 pound bible of Religious Laws and Rituals since they were little!

Any fish in its right mind will quickly dart away from such a judgmental hook of condemnation — leaving the fisherman skunked again!

So if you have ever used that tactic — next time instead of trying to turn them into legalistic law keepers who are futilely attempting to make themselves acceptable to God by good works and religious deeds — try baiting

your hook with the — **GOSPEL OF GRACE** — the Mercy of Christ— the Love of Jesus — and the Goodness of God — and the bite will be on!

For we all need God's Love and Grace along with a fresh understanding of Gospel Truth that God is not mad at us — but rather that He is longsuffering — not wanting anyone to perish — as He gently works by His Spirit to woo and draw us to Him with His Great Love and Mercy!

And every fish — or more accurately every soul that is out there lost and searching — has a specific need at a specific time — and if you find that need — and use the right bait — you will definitely start catching souls!



So here are just a few quick examples of the kind of bait I use when fishing for men — or women — and they will surely work just as well for you!

As most people are simply lost and feel like God could never forgive them — which is a good time to bait your Gospel Hook with John 3:16.

“For God so loved the world He gave His only begotten son — that whosoever believes in Him should not perish but have Eternal Life” — including them!

And for those who have tried church and given up because of despair and failure to overcome a particular sin or addiction — put on the bait of Ephesians 2:6.

“For we are saved by GRACE — not by (religious) works — it is the Gift of God.”

And understand — we are not only saved by God’s Unmerited Grace — we are just as surely kept by His Grace!

And for the lonely and the ones who feel forsaken and all alone — bait your Gospel Hook with Hebrews 13:5

“I will never leave you nor forsake you” — and — “Lo I am with you evermore, even to the ends of the earth!” Matthew 28:20

And for those going through financial difficulty and suffering lack and need — remind them of this mighty promise of God:

“The Lord will supply all your need according to His riches in glory.” Philippians 4:19

And then throw in these faith building words of King David — *“I have been young and now I am old and I have never seen the righteous forsaken nor his seed begging bread!” Psalms 37:25*

And here is still another well known and beloved Psalm that makes for great bait — *“The Lord is my Shepherd, I shall not want” Psalm 23:1*

Coupled with the words of Jesus — *“Fear not little flock, It is your Father’s good pleasure to give you the Kingdom!” Luke 12:32*

And if you’re still not catching fish or getting solid bites — switch your bait over to this wonderful lure which has caught so many who were once in dire straits:

“Delight yourself in the Lord and He will give you the desires of your heart!” Psalm 37:4

Now here is some good fishing bait for those who are in a quandary and in dire need of direction:

“The steps of a man are established by the Lord, when he delights in His way — though he fall, he shall not be cast headlong — for the Lord upholds his hand!” Psalm 32:23-24

And this wonderful promise from another well-known Psalm:

“Trust in the Lord with all your heart — lean not on your own understanding — in all your ways acknowledge Him and — HE WILL DIRECT AND MAKE STRAIGHT YOUR PATHS!” Psalm 3:5-6

And now for those in need of healing — those suffering terrible disease, sickness or injury — especially when no doctor or prescription can cure the condition — here is some sure fire remedial bait for them:

“I am Jehovah Rapha — the Lord Who Heals You!” Exodus 15:26

Coupled with the finished work of Jesus on the Cross and in Pilate’s Judgment Hall whereby scriptures states — *“By His stripes you were healed” 1 Peter 3:12*

All of these healing scriptures and a thousand more powerful Bible promises are all good bait — but the key is to find the right bait for the particular audience — minister to the specific need — and they will surely bite!



For as the Word states — “As many as touched Him were made perfectly whole!” Mark 6:56

All highly effective and powerful miracle working lures that still have the same power they had in the days when the Lord walked this earth in human form — for the Word of God declares:

“Jesus Christ the same yesterday, today and forever!” Hebrews 13:8

And never forget that no matter what the need — or regardless how great the problem — Jesus is the Only Cure — the True Answer — and the Divine Solution to all the needs of humanity!

So find the need — use the right bait — and you will rapidly become a much better Fisher of Men!

And here is the best news — when Fishing for Men — there are no limits on the amount of souls you can catch — no minimum or maximum size restrictions — and no special license required — as all are commissioned to be fisherman — and all can fill their boats — as well as their partner’s boats!

Now let’s jump into another Bible story about fishing — this time Post-Resurrection — the third time Jesus presents Himself alive after He had risen from the dead — as He meets some of His disciples once again on the shores of Galilee — where seven of them have returned to fishing and have fruitlessly toiled all night long without catching a single fish — totally skunked again!

Jesus is on the shore — cooking fish over an open fire — when He calls out to the disciples — “Children, do you have any meat.”

Then He said — “CAST THE NET ON THE OTHER SIDE” — John 21:5 — and the net was so full they were not able to draw it into the boat.

And they immediately recognized Jesus and said — “It is the Lord” — and as the KJV states — “Peter girt his fisher’s coat unto him (for he was

naked) and did cast himself into the sea!” John 21:7

Now for the record — and even though other translations have since changed the text and sanitized this somewhat shocking or abrasive comment — I for one am not into this so-called naked fishing business — but one thing for sure — whether Peter simply had his outer fishing coat off or was indeed fishing stark naked — he did not waste any time getting to the Lord.

And once on land he saw that Jesus already had a bunch of fish being grilled over the fire — and these were not fish the disciples had caught as their net was still out in the water — which indicates Jesus Himself was a fisherman.

I love that — as JESUS IS THE MASTER ANGLER OF ALL FISHERMEN — and He is also the Master Teacher who anoints and teaches us all how to fish for souls!

It is only at this point that Peter and the other disciples drag their net chocker-block full of fish onto the shore — now watch this — for scripture declares there were one hundred and fifty three (153) fish in the net — so

many big fish and yet:

“THE NET WAS NOT BROKEN!” John 21:11

Theologians have long debated why this exact number of fish is recorded so precisely and clearly.

I was just a young believer when I heard what is still considered the most popular and much proclaimed explanation — that there were 153 nations in the world at that time.

Which is another prime reminder that the Gospel is for the entire world — and it must be preached to the entire world — to every creature — every person — every precious soul — in every nation!

So even though some academics may disagree and state there were no nations as we know them



today — little more than vast regions run by kings and chieftains and tribal rulers — I will stick with the spiritual truth that whether there were 153 nations as the early church father Jerome stated or simply ruling tribes over vast regimes — the key point is the universality of the Gospel Message!

Including the clear and final command of Christ that this message of the Good News must be preached to the very ends of the earth — coupled with the marvellous miraculous fact that — **THE NET WAS NOT BROKEN!**

Now let us take a moment to reflect back on the disciple's first encounter — when Jesus instructed them to — *“Launch Out Into The Deep”* — and they caught such a multitude of fish they filled both boats — but in that first draught of fish caught the scripture states — **“THEIR NETS WERE BREAKING”** — *Luke 5:6*

What made the difference — the first instance was Pre-Cross — still under the Old Covenant — relying on its religious rules and rituals and animal sacrifices which could never wash away their sins — as the **NET OF THE LAW** had no power to save anyone — nor the ability to hold the huge catch of fish!

But the second instance is Post-Cross and Post-Resurrection — with the eternal cleansing blood of Christ in the holy tabernacle in heaven — salvation made freely available to all — to every person in the entire world — and still — **THE NET WAS NOT BROKEN!**

Which is exactly what Jesus said would be the greatest sign of His Return:

“And this Gospel of the Kingdom shall be preached — IN ALL THE WORLD — as a Witness — TO ALL NATIONS — and then the end will come!” Matthew 24:14

Which means there is still a lot more fishing for souls to be done before the Lord returns!

And there is a dire need for more fishermen —

and for — **MORE FISHING PARTNERS SO WE CAN FILL ALL THE GOSPEL NETS!**

And as all our Fishing Friends and Gospel Partners know — I have now been fishing with Jesus and for Jesus for almost 50 years — in fact I am now into my 50th year in ministry — and I have successfully fished in over 140 nations — and in more than 560 mass outdoor venues in stadiums, soccer fields and city parks — as well as repeatedly criss-crossed this great nation of Canada.

And God has graciously allowed me to see well over twelve million (12,000,000) precious souls respond to Christ in the salvation calls!

But there are still so many good fishing holes — so many unreached people groups — and so many nations once closed that are in the process of opening up to the Gospel and removing their No Jesus Fishing regulations!



Which is why I am rapidly preparing to go fishing again in just a few weeks to — **PAKISTAN** — for three great outdoor campaigns up in the remote Punjab region — where the populations are almost entirely Muslim — where little if any Gospel has ever been preached — and where the need for Jesus is so great — which will make for another super Fishing Trip — and you my friend can be my Fishing Partner

— so God can fill all of our boats at the same time!

And then right after our Pakistan campaigns — in early November and in direct answer to prayer — God has opened a great and effectual door for our first two outdoor mass campaigns in the Communist nation of — **VENEZUELA** — where all the local churches and leaders are in full support.

Which by God's Grace will be followed by a massive campaign in the capital city of Caracas in early 2027 — all of which is brand new territory — as we continue to steer our Gospel

boat to the once closed regions beyond — to fresh waters which have plentiful and bountiful fishing grounds and — **THE BITE WILL SURELY BE ON!**

And as you may or may not realize — almost all these massive campaigns we have been privileged to hold around the world have been financed by our own ministry — including all the costs of renting stadiums or fields, paying for stage and lights and PA systems and advertising, etc — which has led many to ask — how in the world has a little ministry like this been able to finance all those massive costs!

Believe it or not — the answer to that query is found in yet another Bible Fishing story!

As the people commissioned to gather tribute and collect taxes for Caesar came to Capernaum and asked Peter — *“Does your Teacher not pay taxes?”* — and by the response of Jesus it is debatable whether he should have so readily agreed or not — but Peter replied — *“Yes!”* **Matthew 17:24-25**

So to meet this pressing need — Jesus sent Peter off on another little supernatural fishing venture — not with a net as was the usual case — but this time with a hook and line — and specific instruction to — *“go to the sea, cast in a hook, and TAKE THE FISH that comes up first.”* **Matthew 17:27**

And then Jesus adds this incredible detail:

“And when you have — OPENED ITS MOUTH — you will find a piece of money — A GOLD COIN — take that and give it to them for Me and for you.” **Matthew 27:27**

In essence — He told Peter and He instructs us to go fishing — cast in a hook — catch a fish — open its mouth — take the money out — and pay all the required costs for Me — and for you!



Which indicates that those who we have fished for and caught — those who have been saved — blessed — healed — empowered — or encouraged by this ministry — should stand with the ministry!

In essence — we are to catch them — open their mouths — or open their wallets and purses — and take the gold coin out — and then sow that money into the foreign fields of Mass Evangelism — and in the process lay up eternal treasure!



So in closing — there is still a lot of Gospel Fishing to be done — and it will take a lot of gold coins to meet all the pressing needs of our many upcoming mass campaigns — but the Lord will supply!

And note — just like the morning they went fishing out into the deep when their boat and their partner's boat was filled to overflowing — so it is with this parable — as the multitude of fish caught not only provided for the need of Jesus — but also the need of Peter!



And when you give to Jesus and to Overseas Missions — God will just as surely meet your every need — and at the same time cause you to lay up vast amounts of eternal treasure in heaven!

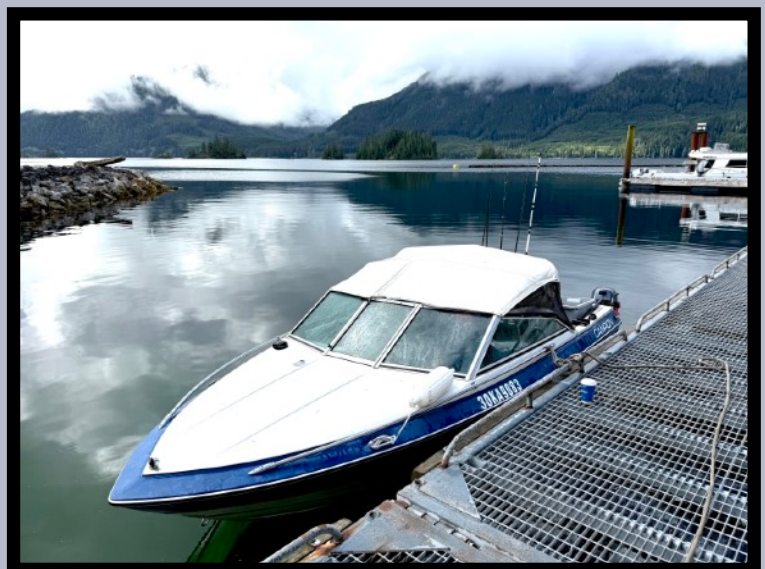
